# Australia

## Description:

(All prices are in US Dollars)

This outfitter owns a 360,000 acre cattle property in the Northern Territory, approximately two and a half hours east of Katherine. This property has a large number of water buffalo roaming the land, and in the past several of the top ten SCI scoring water buffalo have been taken.

New accommodations have been built and are now operating. These accommodations will cater for the non-hunter as well.

Arrival point for the hunts is Darwin, Northern Territory, with the hunt season running from May to September.

Firearms permits will be emailed to you or given to you at the show. This is a critical part of hunting in Australia's Northern Territory as firearms regulations are very strict, but an easy process if you fill out the forms correctly, particularly writing the correct serial number of your firearm, and needs to be done at



least three months before you hunt. This gives them time to post your license back to you. The outfitter will pay for your firearms license permit. They have guns you can use, but you will need to apply for an Australian firearms license.

Flights from the USA will arrive into Sydney or Brisbane and from there up to Darwin where you would get a hotel room for the night which they can arrange, if you let them know in advance. The next day travel down to the hunting area.

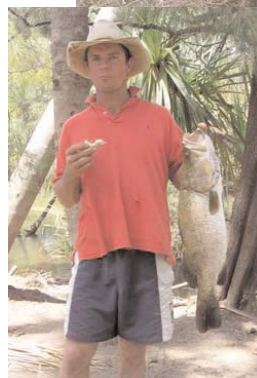

## Accommodations

• Accommodations include two main camps, consisting of comfortable cabin style bunks, cookhouses, and showering facilities. There are also three spike camps, strategically located throughout the guiding territory. All camps have comfortable log cabins located in pristine settings.

• Each of the main camps is limited to four hunters, with one hunter per guide unless otherwise arranged. A cook is provided and our experienced crew of guides are dedicated to making every trip a success.

# British Columbia 2

## Description:

(All prices are in US Dollars)

This outfitter owns the exclusive guiding/outfitting rights to two British Columbia hunting territories.

The first lodge (RR) is located at the end of the north arm on Stuart Lake, approximately 55 miles from Fort St. James, B.C. Access to the lodge is by air or water only. The lodge offers guided hunts for black bear, moose, elk, grizzly bear, deer, wolf, lynx, wolverine and upland game bird hunting (grouse). They also offer excellent fishing for dolly varden, rainbow trout, char, burbot and kokanee. The lodge is open (for hunting) from May 1-June 15 (spring bear) and from Sept. 1-Oct. 15 (all game hunting).

The territory at this lodge is approximately 2500 square kilometers, encompassing two large, and several small, lakes. The terrain has "flats", hills, a mix of fir, spruce, pine, poplar, etc., with numerous trails and back roads and some meadows. Hunting is done mainly on quads, with some walking/hiking, or with trucks or boats. They offer the best in accommodation and their home cooked meals (during the hunting season) are second to none.

This lodge also offers a fabulous setting to spend summer vacations. They have ten fully modernized cabins (including all the amenities), with the capacity to sleep 35 people, panoramic scenery, hiking trails, nesting bald eagles, Osprey fishing "for their dinner", abundant wildlife, a remote location and serenity



beyond belief- what more could you ask for? Summer rentals start on June 1st and end on September 15th.

The second lodge (WC) is located in the northern coastal area of British Columbia and is part of The Great Bear Rain Forest. Their coastal territory covers approximately 4800 square kilometers and is home to some of the best grizzly bear and goat hunting around. The staging area is close to 100 miles from Terrace, B.C. This territory and terrain is mountainous, rocky, timbered and open alpine, with the beautiful Kitlope River flowing through it. Hunting is done with jet boats, on quads, hiking (or trucks when the terrain allows).

Guided hunts offered at the coastal territory are for coastal black bear, grizzly bear, goat, deer and moose. For those who love to fish there are four salmon runs through out our territory. Accommodations, at this time, are for those who like to "rough it". They offer tents with cots for sleeping, camp cooking and campfires. This is truly a "no wimp" hunt but a wonderful experience for anyone up to the challenge.

# Colorado

## Description:

### Rifle Elk and Deer Hunts

Approximately 35,000 acres of private ground surrounded by BLM is yours to explore while enjoying comfortable cabins, hot showers and 4x4 transportation. Combine that with some of the best trophy hunting in Colorado and you have a hunt with this outfitter.

Rifle elk and deer hunts run October through November. They take small groups of 8-10 hunters per hunt with 1 guide for every 2 hunters. One on one hunts can be arranged for an additional fee. Hunts run 5 hunting days with one day in and one day out for travel. You will hunt with skilled guides that are specially screened for their knowledge of the area and the trade. Year after year their guides choose to return to guide for them, and success runs high on most hunts.

All deer hunts in Colorado are on a draw.

The hunt can be as hard or as easy as you would like it to be. They use 4x4 trucks and walking but horses are available. They pick you up at the airport and deliver you back. They have a working cattle ranch that they hunt on. The main house is where you eat and shower, the hunters stay in the bunkhouses which have bunkbeds with mattresses on them. Around 85% of tags are filled depending on the weather and the ability and desire of the hunter.



Late Season Colorado Deer hunts are available. If you would like more information you may write, call or e-mail. Application deadline is April 1st.



### Archery and Muzzleloader Deer & Elk

*All Deer hunts in Colorado are on a draw.*

As traditional as the hunt experienced by our American forefathers, but with the comfort of cabins instead of tents, warm showers, and approximately 35,000 acres of private ground surrounded by BLM. You'll reminisce with pride about your hunting experience with this outfitter for years to come. Muzzleloading elk and deer hunts are taken in the same area as the rifle hunts. The hunts are conducted during the elk rut. They don't use tree stands, they bugle our elk in to our hunters.

The hunts are 1 on 1 with a knowledgeable guide. Other arrangements can be made for couples or groups if requested. You will be able to spend glorious fall days in the Colorado mountains away from the demands of work in pursuit of a magnificent trophy bull or buck. You will be met at the airport and transported to the hunt area.

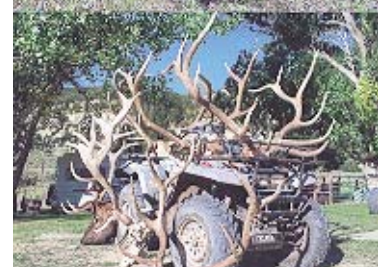

### Mountain Lion Hunts

Our mountain lion hunts are conducted November to March each year. The success of your hunt is limited only by your personal commitment and the weather. As professional houndsmen we use only the most highly trained dogs who are deterred only by rainy or muddy weather. We use 4x4 trucks and snow machines when necessary. The average walk to a treed lion is about a mile. You will be able to take your time.

Your mountain lion hunt can be archery, pistol, rifle, muzzleloader or shotgun. Mountain Lion can be tracked successfully on the dry ground but you spend more time looking for a good track. The dogs are unable to track in the mud or rain so this should be taken into consideration when booking your hunt. Most hunts you will be staying at our house in Norwood although we hunt many areas of Colorado.

# New Zealand

## Description:

(All prices are in US Dollars)

Located on the South Island, this outfitters most popular combination hunt is for Red Stag, Tahr and Chamois. The Red Stag hunts take place on their private ranch in the south of the South Island where you are likely to see numerous free-roaming quality trophies each day. The terrain is moderate hill country, the valleys full with beech forest. Four-wheel-drive vehicles, horses or walking access the area. This part of the hunt last 3 to 4 days on average. Often a hunter can't resist adding a Fallow Buck, or a Wapiti Bull to the package. For the Chamois hunt they shift camps a two-hour drive to Wanaka, a small, growing tourist town situated on the shores of Lake Wanaka. They hunt for Chamois on private property exclusive to them. Chamois is probably the most difficult to hunt because of their sharp senses. Often our hunters prefer to access this area by helicopter which is all part of the package and an experience not to be forgotten. Tahr are plentiful hunted on private property - probably the

best in the world. This is a challenging hunt where the terrain is mountainous, but a very rewarding hunt when successful and back at camp.

Access to this area is by fourwheel-drive. For a combination hunt – Tahr, Chamois, Red Stag – allow yourself 8 to 10 days. Fishing and bird hunting can also be arranged in season, with many good rivers and streams within an hour's drive from camp. Hunts usually finish at the Wanaka Lodge where your trophies are packaged for shipment or for their guests to take with them provided the skins are dry.



The base for your Red Stag, Fallow Buck, Wapiti, Wild Goat and Arapawa Ram hunting is our new Wilderness lodge set amid native tussock and beech forest. Within are all the comforts of home, dining/recreational area, bedrooms, hot showers, flush toilets, which together with food and accommodation are all part of the total hunting package.



**Thar and Chamois hunting is based at our hunting lodge in Wanaka - a small tourist town situated on the shores of Lake Wanaka.**

## LODGING

You will be staying at a clean and comfortable lodge with hot water, a soft bed, purified drinking water, excellent cuisine, and snacks during hunting periods, beverages and everything required to enjoy a great hunt.

## HUNTING METHODS

Guides will be provided 1 x 1 and will accompany hunters at all time. You will be able to hunt with rifle or bow. Also, we offer spot and stalk or safari style hunts depending on your preference. Taking a big one is not easy job; it takes a lot of patience and endurance as well as a bit of good luck.

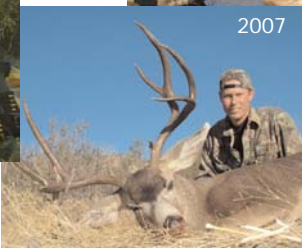

## Archery Hunts

Although the State of Texas offers a bow-only season during the month of October, historically, the bow hunts are not very productive in October for several reasons. As a result, they do not have the normal animal activity around the feed areas as they do during the gun season. Therefore, they only offer bow hunts during the rifle season. The hunts are conducted over prime feed areas in ground blinds and platform stands. 100% opportunity is expected.

- Limit per hunter: 1 Trophy Whitetail Buck, 1 Doe and 1 Turkey
- Food, Lodging, Guide, Trophy Preparation included.
- 5-Day Hunt: Arrive at noon on Day 1 and Leave by noon on Day 5.
- Cost: \$3,500

## Rifle Hunts

### Outback Ranch

Beautiful 12,000 acre ranch with a first class lodge and airstrip. Amenities include a huge fireplace, bar, tv, phone and internet service. This ranch has an outstanding population of free-ranging Whitetails as a result of an 10 year feed and habitat improvement program. Over the last few years they harvested a 14 pt. that scored 168 B&C and another buck that had 11 points with a 26" spread. They also have a picture of a 17-point 180" class buck that had locked horns with a 10-point buck whose horns were cut to release the deer. During the hunt you may also harvest free-ranging exotics, Rio Grande Turkey and mature management bucks. Prices for these animals will be quoted at the time of your hunt. Hunters fly to San Antonio International airport, rent a car and drive to the ranch.

- Limit per hunter: 1 Trophy Whitetail buck.
